Make-up Work

- Students are responsible for getting any work they have missed due to absences. Students will get their work from
 the Absent Work Station in my classroom that is separated into Week 1-6 and is organized by days (Monday-Friday).
 If students have questions on what they have missed they should ask!
- Students are allowed one school day for every day of class missed to make up any work missed. If students do
 not complete the work in the time allotted the late work policy will apply. Students will not be required to take a
 quiz or test on the day returning to class after an absence if the quiz or test was announced during the absence.

Late Work
